

# CAROLINA CLASSICS AT THE CAPITAL

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Carolina Classics at the Capital (“The Event”) will take place Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, August 19<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 in downtown Raleigh, North Carolina. Hundreds of classic cars and parts vendors will be parked in or near the Raleigh Convention Center.
2. Show times will be Friday, 4:00PM to 10:00PM; Saturday, 9:00AM to 6:00PM and Sunday, 9:00AM to 4:00PM. Friday Night cruise in 6PM – 11PM (Free for car show participants.)
3. Admission to the Show will be \$10.00 per person.
4. **Vendor Display Spaces** will be priced as follows on a first-come, first-served basis:
 

One 10 x 20 Space	\$175
Two 10 x 20 Spaces (contiguous)	\$320
Four 10 x 20 Spaces (contiguous)	\$600

(Note: All space sizes are approximate and fees cover the entire three-day event. Wireless Internet access and AC power are available to all vendors for an additional fee.)

5. **Auto Display Spaces** will be priced as follows on a first-come, first-served basis.

6. Round-the-clock security will be provided in all areas by local law enforcement and city staff.
7. Each 10’ x 20’ vendor space includes two (2) admission passes good for all three days. Outdoor vehicle display space includes one (1) admission pass good for all three days. Indoor vehicle display space includes two (2) admission passes good for all three days.
8. Credentials issued by The Event organizers are required for admission at all times—this includes a sticker or placard affixed to the windshield and a Vendor Pass. No exceptions. Lost vendor admission passes will be replaced at a cost of \$5.00 each.
9. Load-in and booth set-up times are: Vendors: Thursday, 8:00AM to 4:00PM and Friday, 8:00AM to 2:00PM. Three-Axle Trailers may only set up 8AM to 12:00NOON on Thursday; Indoor Cars: Thursday, 4:00PM to 7:00PM and Friday 8:00AM to 2:00PM. Absolutely no set-up or load-in outside those windows. 10. Cars, vendors or displays may be relocated or otherwise modified to comply with fire codes or other building regulations at the sole discretion of The Event presenter. All space transfers must be requested in writing, signed by both parties involved. Transfer requests will be accommodated whenever possible but cannot be guaranteed.

11. Vehicles on display inside the Convention Center may not be started at any time after 2:00PM Friday. Batteries must be disconnected and fuel in the tank may not exceed one-eighth capacity. Fuel level will be checked upon arrival.
12. Accommodations are available immediately nearby. More than 1,000 hotel rooms are less than a half-mile from The Event site, most within steps. There are close to a hundred dining establishments—ranging from casual fast food to high-end eateries—all within easy walking distance from The Event. 13. Food and beverage will also be offered on Fayetteville Street and inside the Raleigh Convention Center. Vendors are not permitted to sell food or beverages.
14. This event will be held rain or shine; no rain date will be available.
15. Car haulers may be parked on a first-come, first-served basis, in the city's G Lot (Davie at South Street)
16. Approximately 50,000 people are expected for this event. Abundant public parking is available in garages and lots for \$7.00 per car.
